#### **"New strategic challenges in the face of a global turbulent environment"**

- › The impact of the post-pandemic crisis on global supply chain disruption. Are re-shoring and smart restructuring of traditional supply chains the only remedy to create an efficient global logistics environment?
- › War sanctions imposed on Russia and their detrimental impact on seaports, OBOR and air traffic. How to deal with them?
- › The dominant position of major maritime container operators and its detrimental impact on other links in the logistics supply chain: exorbitant and record-high freight rates with deteriorating service quality.
- › Can the counteraction of shippers and forwarders and market regulators reduce the strong market power of container carriers?
